Road Smart Interactive is coming to our school to teach us about road safety.



Road Smart Interactive teachers will come to my school in a van. They will unload some equipment to make an exhibition and set it up at my school.

The room they set up in might look different to normal.

They might be at our school for more than one day because they are working with different classes. Our teacher will let us know when and where our lesson is.



The exhibition has a big wall with iPads on it.

We might sit on chairs or the floor, or we can stand.

A Road Smart Interactive teacher will give us a talk at the start, and may show us a video. We might also answer some questions.



We might log-in to the iPads.

It will ask us to enter in our details, including our:

- first name
- email address

It will also ask us to take a picture or choose an avatar.



We need to be careful with the iPads because they are fragile.

We cannot eat or drink in the lesson because it is important we keep the iPads clean, so they keep working.



There are six different activity stations.

We can move to the next station when the number comes up on our iPad.

We might work in a group or by ourselves to complete the activities.

Some of the activities have headphones. We can choose to wear the headphones or play the sound aloud.

Each activity will take about five minutes to complete; some may be shorter. We might have to wait if we finish an activity early.



One of the activities is a video on a virtual reality (VR) headset.

We need to stay seated whilst using the VR.

We can watch the video on an iPad instead.



At the end of the lesson, our Road Smart Interactive teacher will talk to us.

We might complete an activity all together on our iPads.

We might ask or answer questions.

At the end of the session, we need to return our iPads to the Road Smart Interactive teachers.
