Colour: See the World in a New Light exhibition

Colour is a special exhibition that is located within Scienceworks.

It is an interactive experience where you can learn about the science behind colour, light, vision, and illusions.

This exhibition will be at Scienceworks until 26 January 2027.



Museum Foyer and Ticketing Desk

I will need to buy a ticket to go into Scienceworks and a special ticket to go into the *Colour* exhibition.

Sensory Bag

Before I go into *Colour*, I can borrow a sensory bag from the information desk if I want to.

A sensory bag contains:

- Noise reduction earmuffs
- Communication card
- Sensory tools

I can use the sensory bag throughout my day at Scienceworks.

I'll need to bring it back to the information desk before I leave.

The information desk is located next to the main ticket desk.



Entering the *Colour* Exhibition

I will need to wait at the entrance to *Colour* to show a staff member my ticket to get inside.

There may be a line because other people want to see the exhibition too.



Entering *Colour*

When I enter *Colour*, I will see a big open space with lots of individual exhibit interactives around the room.

There of lots of different activities to choose from and different ways to play with and experience colour.



Exhibition Interactives: Light Projectors

In the middle of the exhibition space there are 3 big projectors that I can interact with if I choose.

I can use coloured plastic pieces to design and create my own insect to project onto the screen. I can use the plastic pieces to explore mixing colours with light.



Exhibit Interactives:

There are different exhibit interactives throughout the space that engage different senses.

Some of them are touch focused and have buttons that I can press to create different results on the exhibition.

Some of the exhibits have digital screens that I can engage with.



Exhibit Interactives:

Other exhibits have objects I can observe and text I can read to learn about colour in the natural and human-made world.



Exhibit Interactives:

Some of the interactives are physical and I can learn about colour by playing a game.



Exhibit Interactives: Sharing the Space

There might be other people in the space including families, adults, little children and school groups.

I may have to share the exhibitions with other people, and I may have to wait my turn to use an interactive.



Sensory Supports

Some areas around the *Colour* exhibit might be noisy because of other people playing in the exhibit.

I might like to wear the earmuffs from the sensory bag if I think this will help me.

I can also sit down on a bench and use the sensory tools if I feel like taking a break.



Leaving *Colour* - school groups

If I am visiting *Colour* with my school, I might be there for 1 hour. I will ask my teacher how much time we have.

Leaving *Colour* - general public

If I am visiting by myself, with friends or with family, I can reenter *Colour* up to 2 times throughout my day at Scienceworks.
