

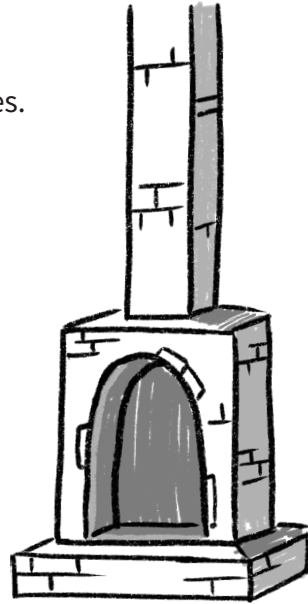
FIRE

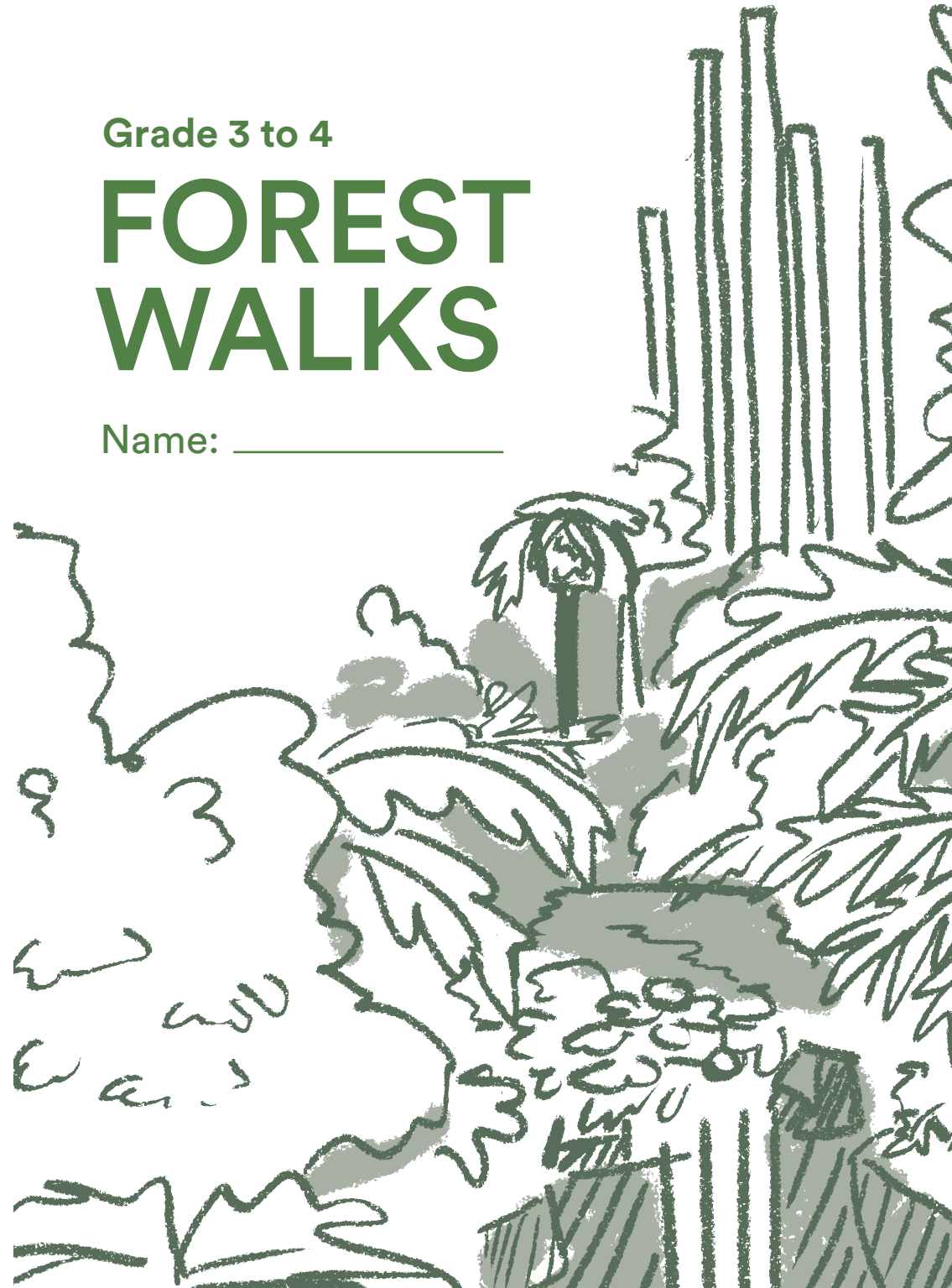
We humans are part of nature.

- Decomposers



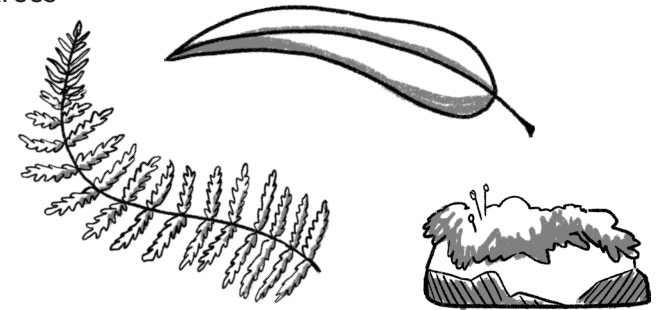
